The impact of Legal Aid

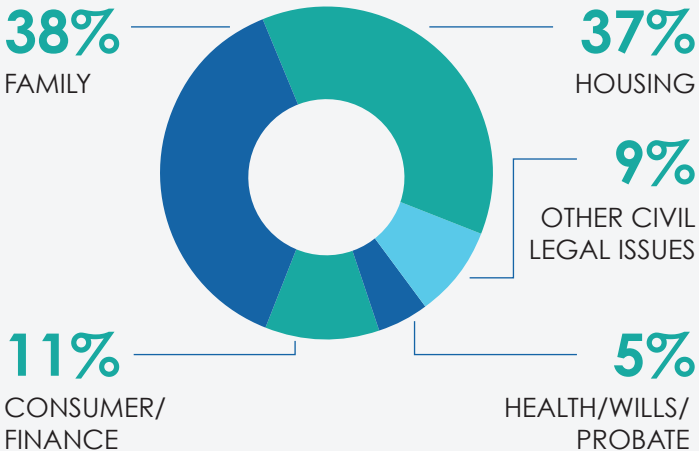
Every \$1 spent on legal aid generates \$7.19 in economic impacts

Legal Lifeline for Youth

Protects children in the foster care system from abuse, homelessness and other adverse effects of poverty.



Domestic Violence

Provide vital legal assistance to survivors of domestic violence improving safety and stability for the family.



Veterans Law

Assist military veterans to secure stable housing, obtain necessary benefits, and remove barriers to employment.
