Every \$1 spent on legal aid generates \$7.19 in economic impacts



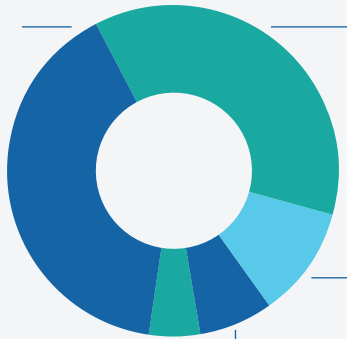
